### Public Policy

Candidates for the Graduate Certificate in Public Policy must complete 24 credit points, including 6 credit points of compulsory core units of study and at least 6 credit points of additional core units of study.

Candidates for the Graduate Diploma in Public Policy must complete 36 credit points, including 6 credit points of compulsory core units of study and at least 6 credit points of additional core units of study.

Candidates for the Master of Public Policy must complete 48 credit points, including 6 credit points of compulsory core units of study, at least 6 credit points of additional core units of study and a maximum of 36 credit points of elective units of study.
